
Over the past year, PTHB Charity also provided funding for a sensory garden for the Community Mental Health Team in Welshpool. Once complete, the garden will be used to help improve both staff and patient wellbeing. Research suggests that being outdoors and using gardening as a therapeutic activity has many positive benefits on people living with dementia. It also provides a safe environment for patients to meet staff and have face-to-face consultations during COVID-19 restrictions.
